Scholarships Recently Added:

A) SMART Scholarship - \$25,000 (Deadline: December 15, 2011)

To be eligible for this scholarship you must:

The SMART Scholarship is open only to citizens of the United States. Persons who hold permanent resident status are not eligible. Proof of citizenship is required. Students must be at least 18 years of age to be eligible. Applicants for undergraduate awards must be currently enrolled in a U.S. college or university.

B) Union Plus Scholarship - \$4,000 (Deadline: January 31, 2012)

The scholarship program is open to students attending a college or university, a community college, or a technical college or trade school.
