1. ACT Composite Score <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• We accept the highest ACT composite score on file (no Super Scores accepted)</li> <li>• No MINIMUM ACT requirement</li> <li>• No time limit on ACT score</li> </ul>	0	36
2. Points for Grades on Core Academic Courses: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ENG 101, MTH 100, BIO 201, BIO 202</li> <li>• A = 3, B = 2, C = 0</li> </ul>	0	12
3. Minimum GPA 2.5 on Pre-Requisite Courses: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ENG 101, MTH 100 or higher, BIO 201, BIO 202, PSY 210, SPH 106/SPH 107</li> <li>• All (6) pre-requisite courses MUST be complete for enrollment/program eligibility. 'In Progress' course at time of application is acceptable.</li> <li>• GPA is calculated on courses taken or accepted in transfer based on grades earned in prerequisite and required general education courses for nursing mobility.</li> <li>• GPA calculation will not include 'in progress' courses and may be calculated on &lt; 6 of the pre-requisite courses.</li> </ul>	2.5	4.0
4. Cumulative 2.0 GPA required at current/most recent institution.	2.0	4.0
5. NACC PN Certificate (Year of completion must be included).	0	5
6. Currently employed as an LPN (include employment verification letter).	0	3
7. Dosage calculation exam: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students will be required to complete a dosage calculation exam prior to admission into the program.</li> <li>• Applicants meeting all minimum admission criteria will be notified via NACC.edu email of their eligibility to sit for the dosage calculation exam.</li> <li>• A score of 90% or higher on the first attempt will receive 10 points towards the application total.</li> <li>• A score of &lt;90% may still be eligible for admission to the program but will receive 0 points towards the application total.</li> <li>• Study materials are available in the nursing department.</li> </ul>	0	10
