Application and Admission Requirements

MLT Program Application Requirements

1. Apply to NACC and be unconditionally admitted and in good standing with the College. To be unconditionally admitted, the Admissions Office must receive official transcripts of all attempted college work.
2. Have official college transcripts from each college previously attended sent to NACC Admissions.
3. Complete the application to the MLT program by the published deadline. It is the student's responsibility to verify all required documentation has been received/uploaded by the published deadline.
4. An ACT composite score is required to be on file. The student is responsible for submitting the ACT report/official results to the NACC Admissions Office.
5. A minimum of 2.5 grade point average (GPA) for all required general Pre-MLT courses.
6. To be eligible for Fall 2026 MLT Program admission, the minimum requirements are ENG, MTH, BIO and CHM successfully completed by the end of summer.
7. Minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA at current institution (which includes all coursework completed) and cumulative 2.5 GPA at institution from which student is transferring.
8. Good standing with the college.
9. Students must meet the essential functions and technical standards required for the program as documented on the required **MLT Technical Standards Form**.
10. Submit completed MLT Application Score Card.
11. Submit the MLT Program application with all required documentation by the deadline. Applications received after the deadline will be considered on a space available basis.

Admission to the MLT program is competitive and the number of students accepted is limited by the number of faculty and clinical facilities available. **Meeting minimal requirements does not guarantee acceptance.** After meeting minimum criteria, applicants are ranked using a point system.

Should the student decline acceptance or be denied admission based on qualifications, he/she must resubmit an application by the published deadline of the following academic year. It is the student's responsibility to adhere to the admission requirements described and verify all required documentation has been received by published deadline. **Students should contact the MLT program advisor for clarification, if needed.**

Application Checklist

- Complete and submit a college admissions application to the admissions office and receive a NACC student number.
- Complete and submit online application to the Medical Laboratory Technician program (separate from college application with all unofficial college transcripts from all colleges attended. (Including NACC unofficial transcript).
- Have an unconditional admission to the college.
- Be in good standing with the college.
- Submit official high school transcripts showing graduation **OR** official GED report to the Admissions Office.
- Submit official transcripts from ALL other colleges attended to the Admissions Office.
- Have a minimum of 2.5 cumulative grade point average (GPA) calculated on the required academic core courses for the Medical Laboratory Technician Program.
- Have taken the National or Residual ACT and have official scores submitted to the NACC Admissions Office. An unofficial copy of ACT scores must be uploaded with the Medical Laboratory Technician application.
- Have completed Pre-Medical Laboratory Technician courses with a grade of C or higher.
- Meet the eligibility criteria and technical standards required for the Medical Laboratory Technician Program.
- Complete and submit MLT Application Score Card.

If you have previously attended another Medical Laboratory Technician program prior to applying to our program, the Medical Laboratory Technician program director at your prior college must provide a letter of Good Standing on your behalf. It is your responsibility to contact your prior college Medical Laboratory Technician program director and request the letter of Good Standing. This letter must be sent directly to the NACC MLT Program Director from the Medical Laboratory Technician program director at your prior college.

1. Medical Laboratory Technician Application
2. Unofficial transcripts from all colleges attended
3. Unofficial copy of ACT Results
4. MLT Scorecard
