

Developmental RDG/ENG Course Information

- RDG 084 must be completed by the student's second semester
- RDG 084 is paired with PSY 200 for most Programs of Study
- All RDG 084 students must take a post ACCUPLACER reading test and attain a minimum score of 70 to successfully complete the course.
- All ENG 092 students must take a post ACCUPLACER English placement test at the end of the semester to determine if they place into the targeted course ENG 093 or ENG 101. If not, the student must re-enroll into ENG 092 another semester.
- All ENG 093 students must successfully complete an End-of-Term essay and their 093 coursework to be eligible to enroll into ENG 101.
- The Mustang Learning Community links ENG 093, MTH 098 & BSS 115 for a collaborative learning experience each fall and spring semester
- Each semester ENG 093 has one section that is formatted as an integrative English and reading course, so a student may receive credit for both ENG 093 and RDG 084 after taking a post reading ACCUPLACER placement test and earning a passing score.
- Developmental math (Emporium model)--a student can complete more than one math course per semester; thus fast-tracking through developmental mathematics.
